Signing of the Agreement on Technical Cooperation Between Japan and the Marshall Islands

Date: November 27th, 2020
Majuro, Marshall Islands

On November 27, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of Japan to the Republic of the Marshall Islands, H.E. Norio Saito and Hon. Casten Ned Nemra, Minister of Foreign Affairs and Trade, signed “the Agreement on Technical Cooperation between the Government of Japan and the Government of the Republic of the Marshall Islands”.

The Agreement sets forth comprehensive measures and actions to be taken by the Government of the Marshall Islands for Japan’s technical cooperation, such as dispatch of technical experts, feasibility study missions and provision of technical trainings.

By concluding the Agreement, it is expected to promote smooth implementation of Japan's technical cooperation and contribute furthermore to economic and social development of the Marshall Islands.

At the ceremony, both H.E. Ambassador Saito and Hon. Casten Nemra confirmed that the Agreement would benefit mutually in proceeding and implementing technical cooperation between Japan and the Marshall Islands.
