

広島「黒い雨」に遭われた方へ

一定の要件を満たすと認められる方は、被爆者健康手帳を受け取ることができます。



「黒い雨」に遭ったと思われる方は、被爆者健康手帳の交付申請をしてください。

申請書・診断書の様式は、大使館等※でお渡しします。

※お住まいの地域に設置されている日本国政府の大使館又は領事館（台湾においては、財団法人交流協会）

申請は運用開始日（2022年4月1日）より前でも受付できます。

2022年4月1日から新たに被爆者健康手帳を受け取るための要件は次の2つです。

要件① 広島「黒い雨」に遭ったこと

- 「黒い雨」に遭い、遭った場所・時間帯、降雨状況、生活状況などが2021年7月の広島「黒い雨」訴訟判決の原告と同じような事情にあったことが確認できること。

※ 要件に該当するかどうかは、必要に応じて広島「黒い雨」に遭った事実に関する書類（居住地や通学先・勤務先の分かるものなど）を求め、個別に審査します。

※ ご家族から「黒い雨」に遭ったと言われた記憶があるが、ご自身が「黒い雨」に遭ったかどうかは分からない場合など、手帳交付の対象になるか不明なときは、裏面の問い合わせ先までご相談ください。

～広島「黒い雨」～

広島に投下された原子爆弾による「黒い雨」については、広島原爆戦災誌に、次のように記録されています。

しゅうりゅう
驟雨（黒い雨）

被爆当日は、終日、巨大な塔状の積乱雲が発達した。その黒雲は、爆発後二〇分ないし三〇分から、つぎつぎと北北西方へ移動していき、午前九時から午後四時ごろの間にわたって「驟雨現象」を起した。

驟雨（にわか雨）は、市中心部では軽く、西部（己斐・高須方面）と北部（可部方面）では土砂降りの豪雨となった。

要件② 障害を伴う一定の疾病にかかっていること

- 11種類の障害を伴う一定の疾病のいずれかにかかっていることが確認できること。

※ 障害を伴う一定の疾病（原子爆弾の放射能の影響によるものでないことが明らかであるものを除く）にかかっているかどうかは、提出していただいた診断書をもとに審査します。

◇ 11種類の障害を伴う一定の疾病

① 造血機能障害を伴う疾病
再生不良性貧血、鉄欠乏性貧血など

② 肝臓機能障害を伴う疾病
肝硬変など

③ 細胞増殖機能障害を伴う疾病
悪性新生物など

④ 内分泌腺機能障害を伴う疾病
糖尿病、甲状腺機能低下症など

⑤ 脳血管障害を伴う疾病
くも膜下出血、脳出血、脳梗塞など

⑥ 循環器機能障害を伴う疾病
高血圧性心疾患、慢性虚血性心疾患など

⑦ 腎臓機能障害を伴う疾病
慢性腎炎、慢性腎不全など

⑧ 水晶体混濁による視機能障害を伴う疾病
白内障

白内障の手術歴がある場合（眼内レンズ挿入者）は、白内障にかかっているとみなします。

⑨ 呼吸器機能障害を伴う疾病
肺気腫、慢性間質性肺炎、肺線維症など

⑩ 運動器機能障害を伴う疾病
変形性関節症、変形性脊椎症など

⑪ 潰瘍による消化器機能障害を伴う疾病
胃潰瘍、十二指腸潰瘍など

手続きの流れ

申請 受付

お住まいの地域に設置されている大使館等において、被爆者健康手帳の交付申請を受け付けます。受付された申請書類は、広島県（現在の広島市内で「黒い雨」に遭った方は広島市）に送付されます。

- ・大使館等において本人確認を行います。
- ・申請には、次の関係書類の添付が必要となります。
 - ・「黒い雨」に遭った事実に関する書類（居住地や通学先・勤務先の分かるものなど）
 - ・診断書（健康管理手当用）（障害を伴う一定の疾病にかかっていることを確認できる診断書）
- ・申請は運用開始日（2022年4月1日）より前でも受付できます。
- ・必要に応じて追加資料の提出や面談を求める場合があります。

審査

広島県（現在の広島市内で「黒い雨」に遭った方は広島市）が、申請内容について要件に該当するかどうか審査します。

- ・申請内容確認の為、審査には一定の時間を要します。

結果

広島県（現在の広島市内で「黒い雨」に遭った方は広島市）が、大使館等を経由して、申請者に審査結果を通知し、要件に該当する方に被爆者健康手帳を交付します。

- ・2022年3月31日までに申請した場合、運用開始日（2022年4月1日）から有効になります。

■ 健康管理手当の申請を同時に行うことが可能です。

- ・支給対象は、現在、障害を伴う一定の疾病（白内障の手術歴（眼内レンズ挿入者）のみの場合は除きます）にかかっている方です。
- ・申請内容について、認定審査が行われます。（審査には一定の時間を要します。）
- ・**2022年4月末日まで**に手当の申請をした場合、**2022年5月分の手当から支給**されます。
- ・同時申請を行い、健康管理手当の申請書に診断書を添付した場合、被爆者健康手帳の交付申請書への診断書の添付は不要です。

People recognized to satisfy certain requirements may get the health handbooks for atomic bomb survivors.



We ask people who think they were exposed to "black rain" to please apply for the issuance of a health handbook for atomic bomb survivors.

The blank application form and medical certificate form are available at embassies, etc.*

*The embassy or consulate of the Government of Japan established in the region where you live (in Taiwan, the Exchange Association)

Applications can be received even before the operation commencement date (April 1, 2022).

There are the following two requirements for newly getting a health handbook for atomic bomb survivors from April 1, 2022.

Requirement (i) Exposure to the "black rain" of Hiroshima

- It must be possible to confirm that you were exposed to "black rain" and that your exposure place and period of time, the rainfall situation, and your life situation, etc. were similar to the circumstances of the plaintiffs in the Hiroshima "black rain" court ruling of July 2021.

*We will individually examine whether or not you meet the requirements by asking for documents containing facts about your exposure to the "black rain" of Hiroshima (documents showing your place of residence, school, workplace, etc.) as necessary.

*When it is unclear whether you are eligible for handbook issuance, for example in the case that you have a memory of being told by your family that you were exposed to "black rain" but you do not know yourself whether or not you were exposed to "black rain," please consult with the contact people stated on the reverse side of this document.

~ The "black rain" of Hiroshima ~

The "black rain" caused by the atomic bomb dropped on Hiroshima is recorded in the following way in the Record of the Hiroshima A-bomb War Disaster.

Sudden showers (black rain)

On the day of the bombing, enormous, tower-shaped cumulonimbus clouds developed all day. Those dark clouds moved one-by-one in the north-northwest direction from 20 minutes to 30 minutes after the explosion, and the "sudden shower phenomenon" occurred from about 9am to 4pm.

The sudden showers (rain showers) were light in the city center, and a heavy downpour in the western areas (in the Koi and Takasu direction) and northern areas (in the Kabe direction).

Requirement (ii) Having certain diseases which are accompanied by impairment

- It must be possible to confirm that you have any of the 11 types of certain diseases which are accompanied by impairment.
- * We will examine whether or not you have certain diseases which are accompanied by impairment (excluding diseases which were clearly not due to the impact of radiation from the atomic bomb) based on the submitted medical certificate.

◇ 11 types of certain diseases which are accompanied by impairment

Steps in the Procedure

Receipt of application

Applications for issuance of health handbooks for atomic bomb survivors are received in the embassies, etc. established in the region where you live. The received application forms are sent to Hiroshima Prefecture (Hiroshima City in the case of people who were exposed to "black rain" inside the current Hiroshima City).

- Identity confirmation is carried out in the embassies, etc.
- The following relevant documents must be attached to the application.
 - Documents containing facts about your exposure to the "black rain" (documents showing your place of residence, school, workplace, etc.)
 - A Medical certificate (for healthcare allowances) (a medical certificate which can confirm that you have certain diseases which are accompanied by impairment)
- Applications can be received even before the operation commencement date (April 1, 2022).
- You may be asked to submit additional materials or attend an interview, as necessary.

Examination

Hiroshima Prefecture (Hiroshima City in the case of people who were exposed to "black rain" inside the current Hiroshima City) examines whether or not the application content satisfies the requirements.

- A certain amount of time is required for the examination in order to confirm the application content.

Result

Hiroshima Prefecture (Hiroshima City in the case of people who were exposed to "black rain" inside the current Hiroshima City) will notify the applicant of the examination result via the embassy, etc. and will issue a health handbook for atomic bomb survivors to those people who satisfy the requirements.

- In the case that the application is made by March 31, 2022, it will take effect from the operation commencement date (April 1, 2022).

■ Making the application for healthcare allowances simultaneously is allowed.

- The people eligible to receive the payment are people who currently have certain diseases which are accompanied by impairment (excluding the case of people with a surgical history of cataracts (who have implanted an intraocular lens) only).
- A certification examination of the application content will be implemented. (A certain amount of time is required for the examination.)
- In the case that you make an application for the allowance **by the last day of April 2022, the allowance for May 2022 will be the first paid.**
- In the case that you made simultaneous applications and attached a medical certificate to the application form for the healthcare allowances, attachment of a medical certificate to the application form for the issuance of a health handbook for atomic bomb survivors is not necessary.
